About the Position: Closer to Home is seeking a dedicated, community-minded individual to join our Family Resource Network Hub (FRN) as a Summer Camp Volunteer for the Wellness Booster Camp in Airdrie. In this vital role, you will be on the front lines of creating a safe, inclusive, and high-energy environment for children and youth. This position is perfect for someone looking to make a meaningful local impact, build leadership skills, and support family wellness within the Airdrie community.

Responsibilities:

- Facilitate engaging recreational activities and serve as a positive mentor and role model for participants.
- Support operational logistics behind the scenes to ensure smooth program execution.
- Serve as a reliable ambassador for Closer to Home, maintaining a community-minded attitude during participant drop-offs.

Qualifications:

- Must be available from July 6, 2026 to July 17, 2026 (specific days/hours to be discussed in interview).
- Demonstrated ability and previous experience working with children/youth.
- Ability to travel independently to and from the Closer to Home Airdrie camp location.
- Self-motivated individual with the ability to maintain a high degree of professionalism and confidentiality
- Able to work well in a team environment
- Highly organized, adaptable and able to effectively manage multiple priorities at one time
- Exceptional written and verbal communication skills; comfortable interacting with people from a variety of backgrounds
- Culturally competent and able to conduct yourself in a respectful manner, encouraging of the cultural/spiritual beliefs and practices of others

- A Police Information Check with a Vulnerable Sector Search and an Intervention Record Check must be completed prior to commencement. Any convictions or records should be disclosed before hire
- Current First Aid Level C from an Alberta OHS Approved agency
- This position requires travel to and from locations around the city. We ask that the successful candidate have a driver's license and access to a reliable vehicle
- Experience working in a non-profit setting is considered an asset

Required Competencies: All positions at Closer to Home Community Services require (5) competencies: *Instills Trust, Consumer Focus, Communicates Effectively, Situational Adaptability and Ensures Accountability.*
